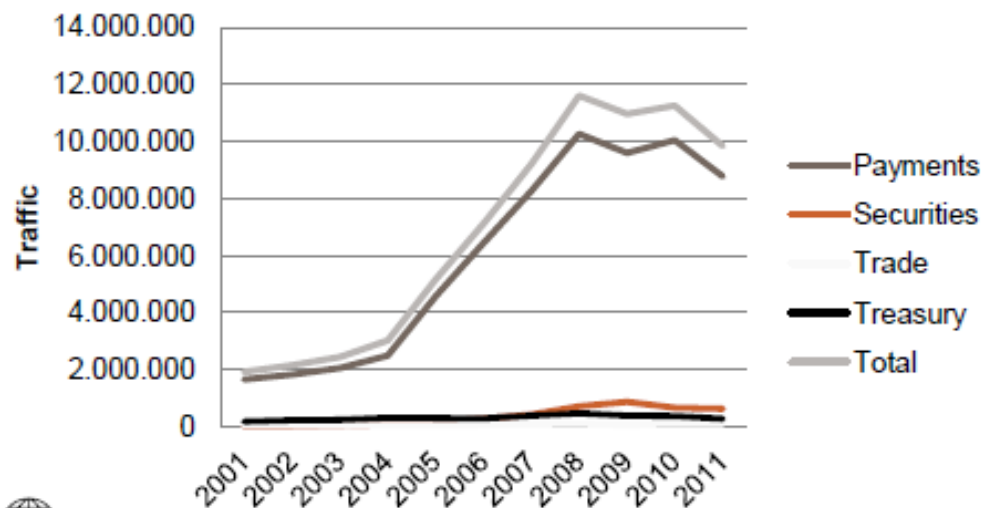
SWIFT in Belgium

Key messages and takeaways ...

- Regulation: still significant post-crisis, and banks are ready to take action
- Collaboration and cooperation: banks must continue to work together to face regulatory and economic challenges.
- West-East shift: new opportunities arising in developing economies, but hard choices, focused investment and willingness to adapt will be necessary
- New dynamics emerging in 'new' markets which are increasingly less dependent on the 'old' world
- Social media: increasingly part of consumers' lives and banks need to catch up to stay relevant

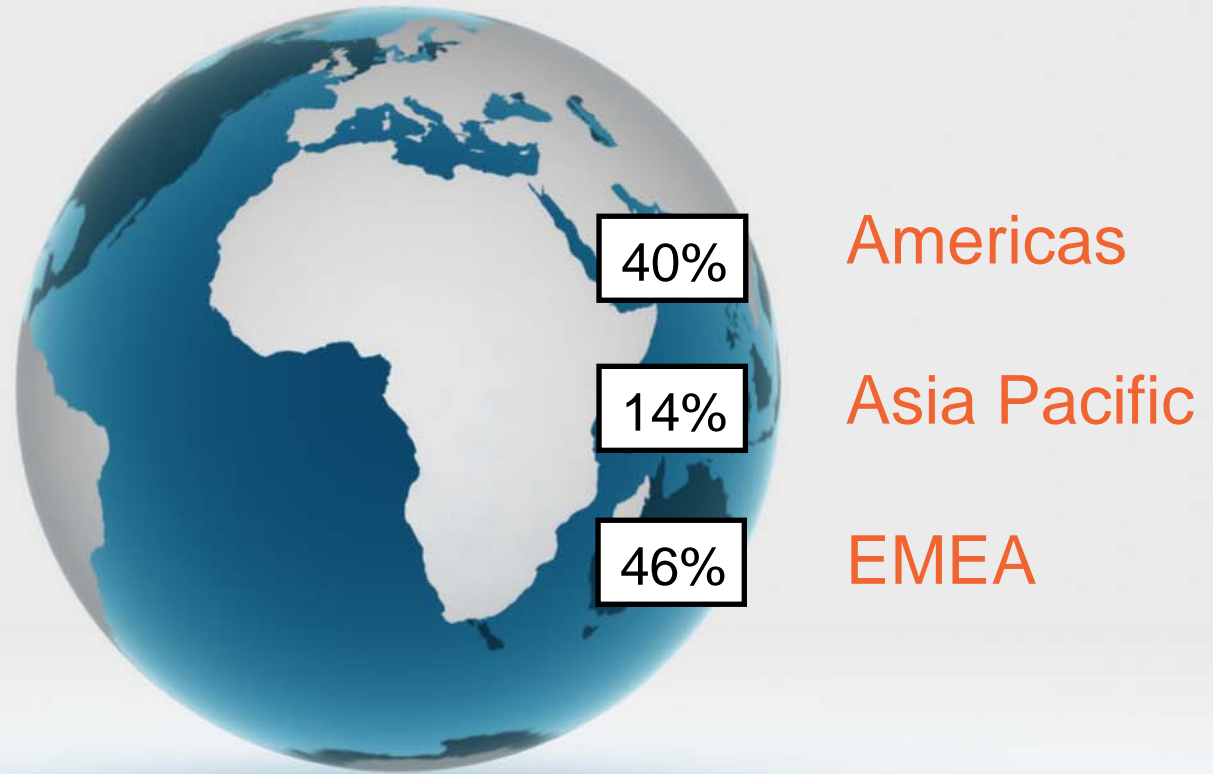

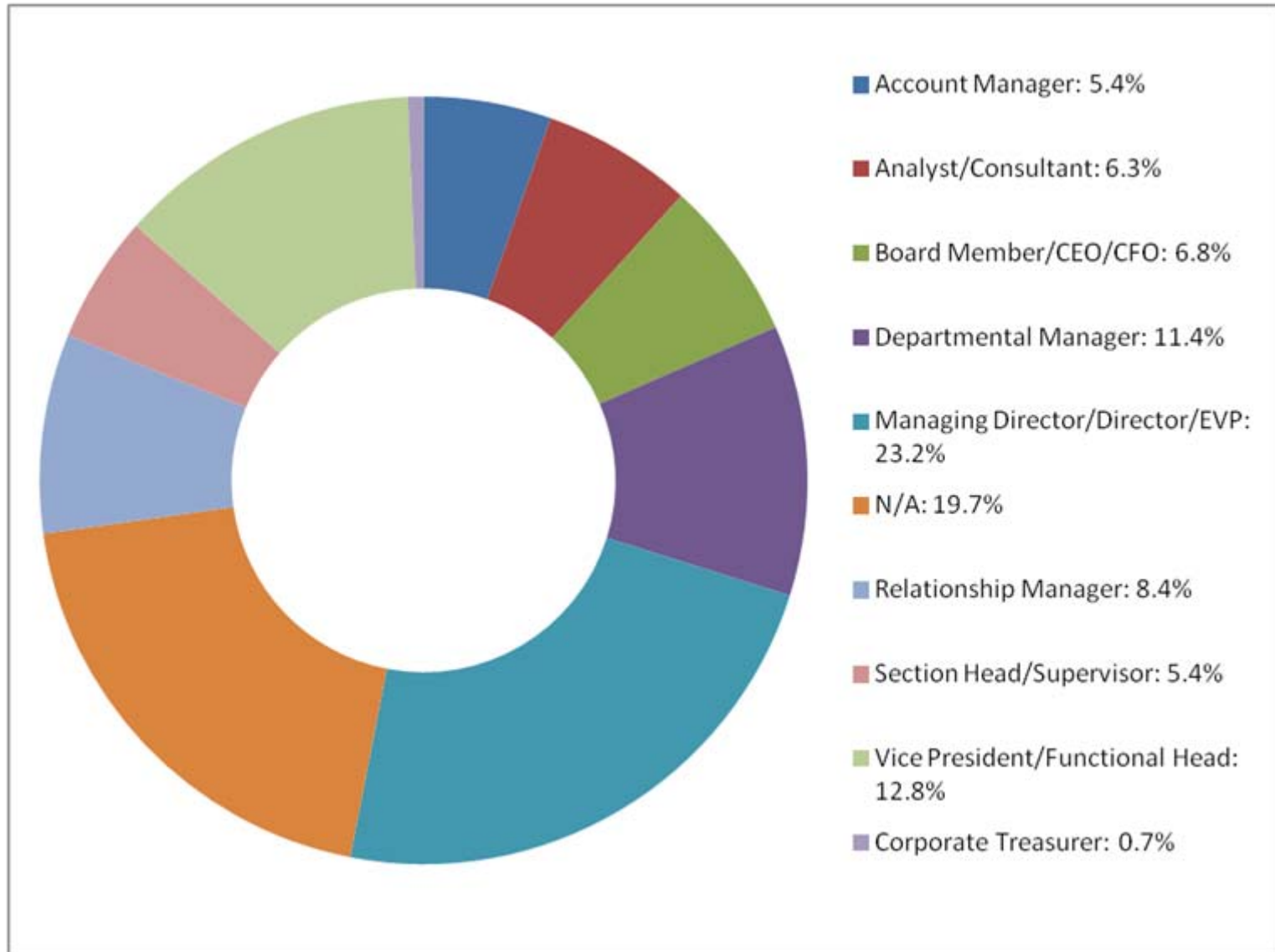

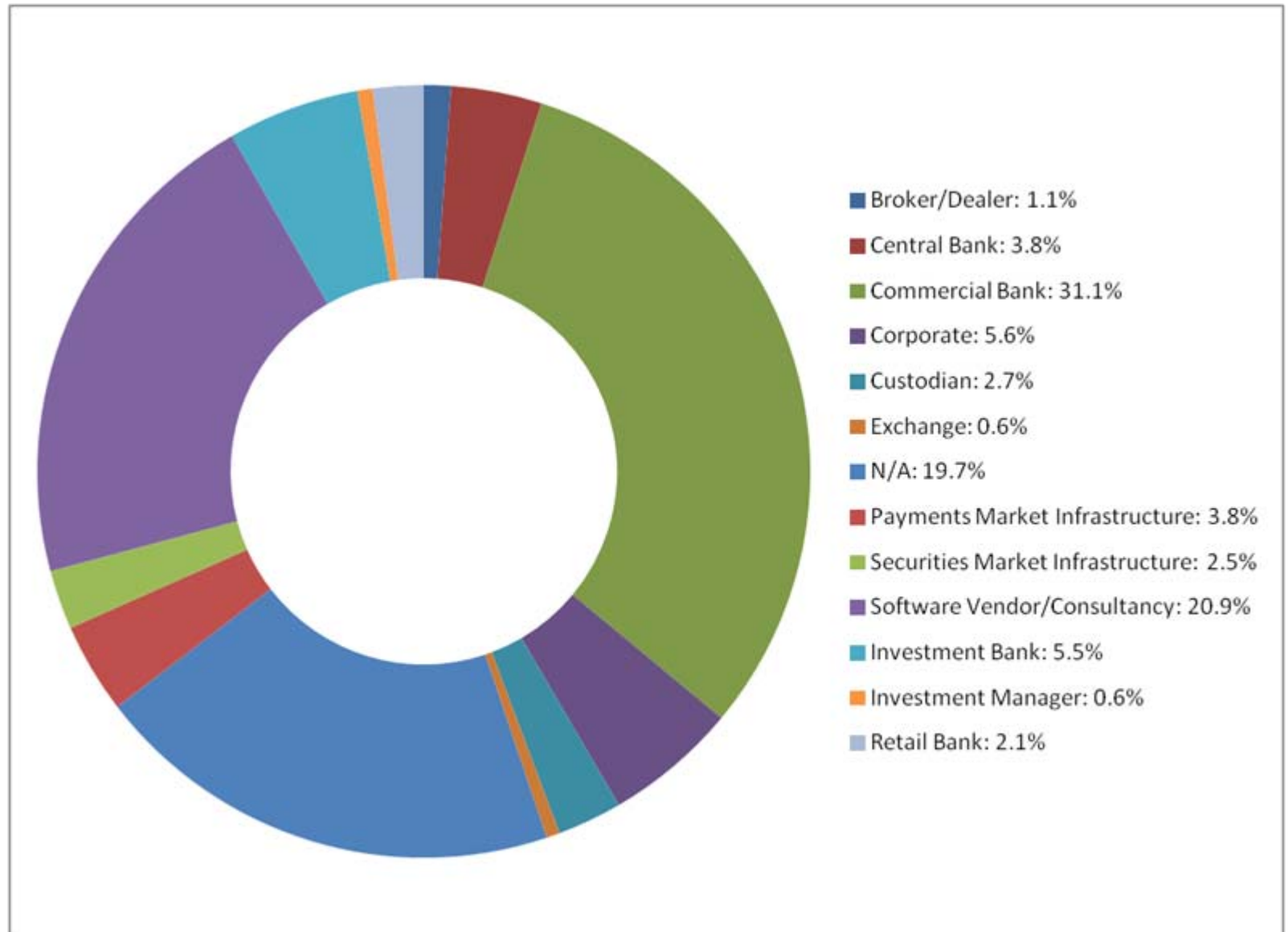
